MARY KAY CANCER RESEARCH GRANTS



The Mary Kay Foundation

WELLSTONE FELLOWSHIP FOR SOCIAL JUSTICE



<u>Families USA</u>, a national nonprofit, non-partisan organization dedicated to the achievement of high-quality, affordable healthcare for all Americans, is accepting applications for the Wellstone Fellowship for Social Justice and the Villers Fellowship for Health Care Justice.


Each year, one person is chosen for each of these fellowships through a competitive process. The selected fellows will work in Families USA's Washington, D.C., office for one year beginning in late summer or fall.

The Wellstone Fellowship for Social Justice is designed to foster the advancement of social justice through participation in healthcare advocacy work that focuses on the unique challenges facing many communities of color. The Wellstone Fellowship is designed to increase the number of low-income, American Indian and Alaska Native, Asian American, Black/African American, Latino, and Native Hawaiian and Pacific Islander social justice leaders. Candidates seeking consideration for the fellowship

must demonstrate an interest in healthcare policy as a tool for reducing racial and ethnic health disparities and in using organizing and advocacy skills to achieve social change. The Wellstone Fellow works with Families USA's Minority Health Initiatives and Field department. The fellowship runs from August 2011 through July 2012, and the fellow will receive a compensatory package that includes an annual salary of approximately \$38,000 and excellent healthcare benefits. The Villers Fellowship for Health Care Justice was created to inspire and develop the next generation of healthcare justice leaders. During their year-long tenure, Villers Fellows will work on a variety of healthcare justice issues and develop an understanding of the federal legislation process. They will also be exposed to different advocacy strategies, including producing analytic reports, disseminating effective messages through the media, successful coalition building, and e-advocacy techniques. The Villers Fellow works in Families USA's Health Policy department. The fellowship will run from August 2011 through July 2012, and the fellow will receive a compensatory package that includes an annual salary of approximately \$38,000 and excellent healthcare benefits. PEY BACK GRANTS FOR AT-RISK YOUTH



The <u>PeyBack Foundation</u> is a nonprofit organization established by Indianapolis Colts quarterback Peyton Manning to assist programs that provide leadership and growth opportunities for at-risk children in <u>Indiana</u>, <u>Louisiana</u>, <u>and Tennessee</u>. The foundation has distributed more than \$4.3 million in grants since 2002, including a total of \$800,000 in 2011 to one hundred forty-seven youth-based organizations.

The foundation focuses primarily on economically disadvantaged youth. Emphasis is placed on programs that have a direct benefit to children through relationships and activities. Programs that are intended to enrich the lives of disadvantaged youth through activities conducted outside the typical school day (i.e., after-school and summer programming) are particularly favored. Funding will only be provided to support programspecific expenses, not an organization's general administrative expenses.


Applicants must be nonprofit 501(c)(3) organizations serving economically disadvantaged children between the ages of 6 and 18 in Indiana, Tennessee, and the New Orleans metropolitan area.

Grants are limited to a maximum of \$15,000; most grants funded are around \$10,000. The foundation prefers not to be the only financial resource for a program. Applications demonstrating collaborative efforts with partnering organizations will be given priority.






